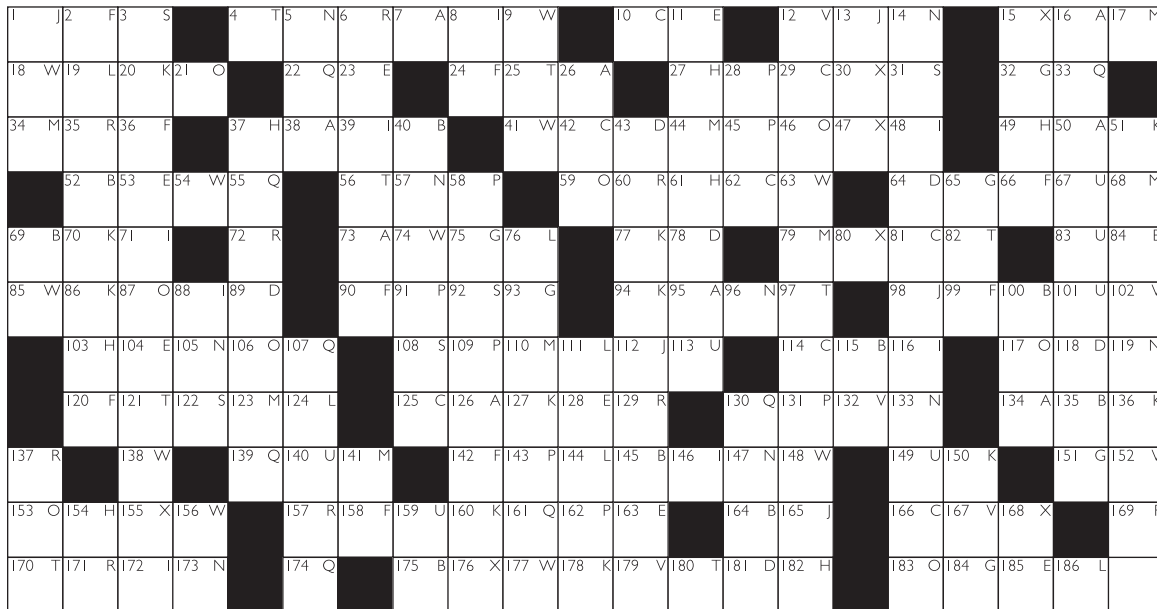


ACROSTIC ALBERTA No. 29 by J.B. Hohm
