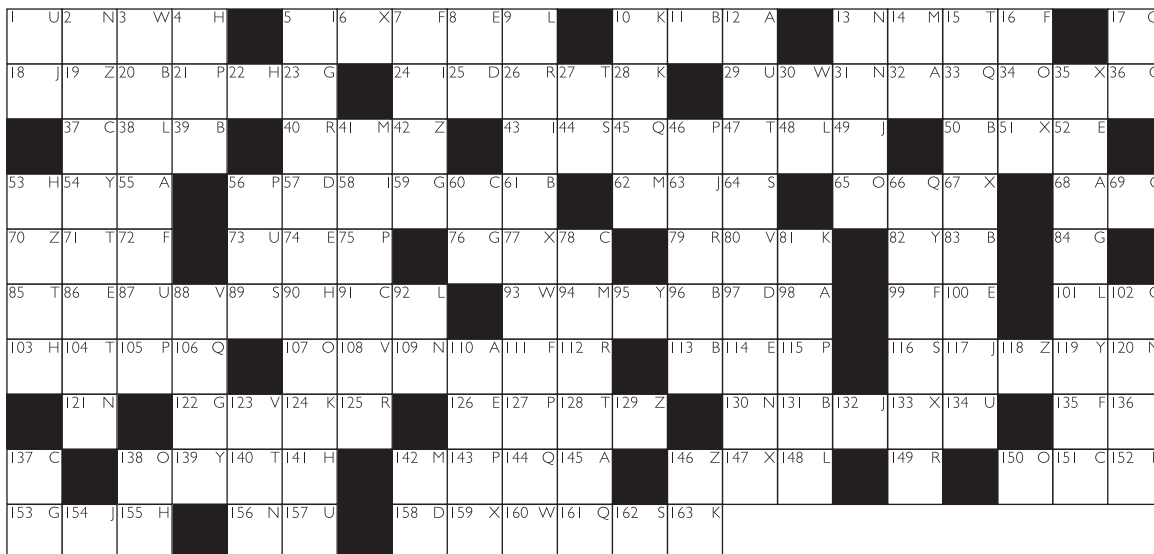


ACROSTIC ALBERTA NO. 28
