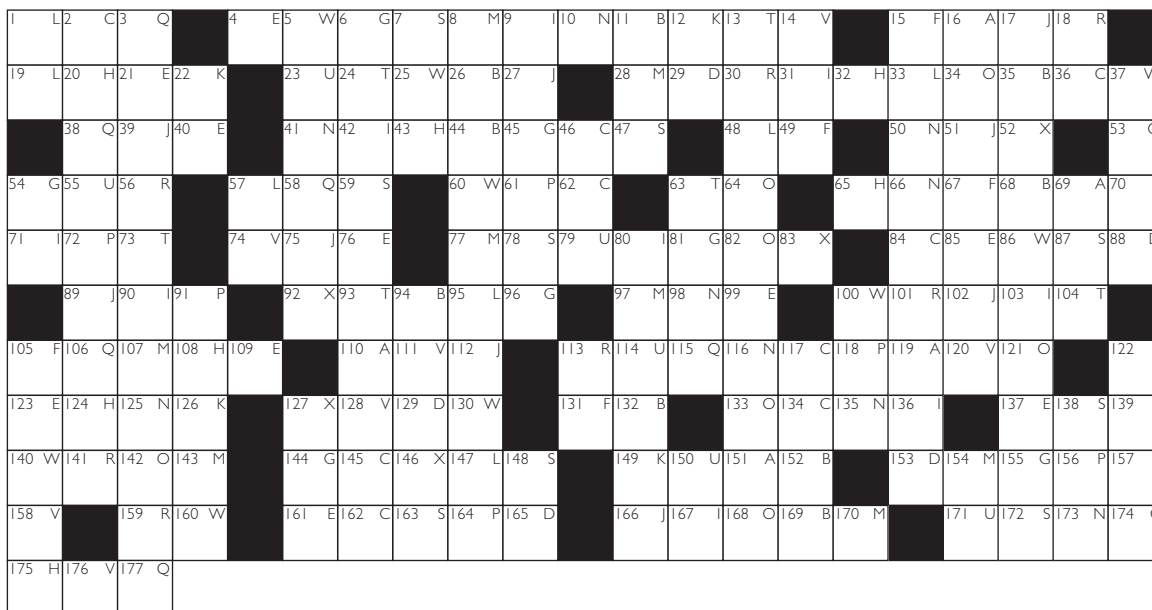


ACROSTIC ALBERTA No. 31 by J.B. Hohm
