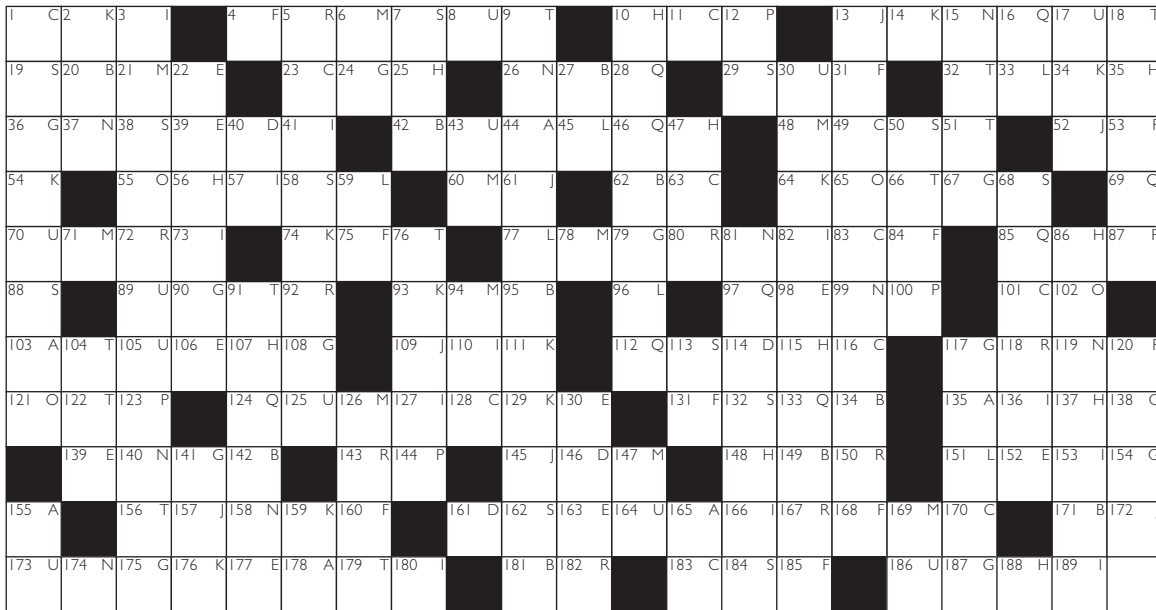


ACROSTIC ALBERTA No. 32 by J.B. Hohm
