

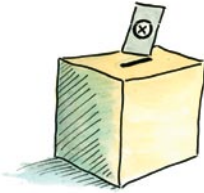

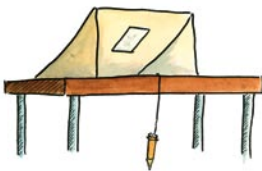

Human fatality rate on Trans-Canada highway through Banff compared to Alberta average on two-lane highway: 5 times; compared to four-lane highway: 10 times
Kilometres of Trans-Canada highway in Banff National Park: 83; kilometres of highway "upgraded" with fencing and overpasses/underpasses for wildlife crossing as of late 1990s: 47; total space animals now have within which they can cross highway in those 47 km: 450 metres; number of documented grizzly bear highway "crossings" between Nov 1996 and Mar 2002: 51
Money required, approximately, to complete upgrading of highway: \$160-million; money available: \$50-million
Money Parks Canada needs annually for highway maintenance: \$14-million; money allocated in budget: \$400,000
